NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Bromadiolone is an indirect anticoagulant. Phytomenadione, Vitamin K₁ is antidotal. Determine prothrombin times not less than eighteen hours after consumption. If elevated, administer Vitamin K₁ and continue until prothrombin time normalises. Continue determination of prothrombin time for three days after withdrawal of antidote and resume treatment if elevation occurs in that time.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE ONLY AS DIRECTED! Handle with care.

The wearing of gloves while handling bait is essential and the use of tamper-resistant bait stations / boxes is MANDATORY!

USES: For use in the garden, home, by farming community, industries, pest control operators and public health.

IMPORTANT:

- Search for and burn/bury all rodent bodies, **do not place in refuse bins or on rubbish dumps.**
- Remove all remains of bait and bait containers after treatment and bury or burn.
- Empty containers completely and dispose of safely.

Poisonous to fish, birds and wildlife. Store away from food and feedstuffs. Keep in original container, tightly closed, in a safe place. Keep out of reach of children, uninformed persons and animals.

TOMCAT ALL-WEATHER BLOX is a rodenticide. It is weather resistant and may be used in both moist and dry areas. Rodents must consume the bait for 3-5 days to produce a delayed mortality (6-15 days). Replace stale, damp and mouldy bait with fresh bait. Placing in concealed locations where rats and mice feed unobserved is desirable.

RATS: Place 9 to 43 TOMCAT ALL-WEATHER BLOX

(usually at intervals of 5 to 10 metres) per placement.

Place bait in burrows and runways, along walls, or where rats are accustomed to feed. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

HOUSE MICE: Place 1 to 2 TOMCAT ALL-WEATHER BLOX

at intervals of 2-4 metres per placement, where mice or their signs have been observed. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease. Place bait in such a way that it is inaccessible to animals, birds and children or sheltered by loose boards or tiles.

Collect unused, spoiled or unconsumed bait and dead rodents and dispose of in a responsible manner.

HOUSE MICE: Place 1 **TOMCAT ALL-WEATHER BLOX** at

intervals of 2-4 metres per placement, where mice or their signs have been observed. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease. Place bait in such a way that it is inaccessible to animals, birds and children or sheltered by loose boards or tiles.

Collect unused, spoiled or unconsumed bait and dead rodents and dispose of in a responsible manner.
